# NES Group clocks onto an automated timesheet solution

## Client

Multinational company NES Group specialises in technical, engineering, rail and IT engineering services and recruitment. Its global client list ranges from small niche industry organisations to blue-chip companies.

## Challenge

NES Group has offices throughout the Americas, Asia, the Middle East, Europe and Africa and over 3,500 personnel out on assignment around the world. With these figures constantly expanding, the company needed a single highly flexible timesheet capture system that would work globally. ## Solution
